



- 1 Connect the THX Onyx™ to your Android device, then plug your headphones into the THX Onyx.

- 3 Tap the gear icon in top right and choose Settings.










4 Scroll down and set **DSD Output Format** to **DoP**.







Using the USB-A adapter and a slim Lightning to USB Camera adapter as pictured below, connect the THX Onyx to your iOS device and then plug your headphones into the THX Onyx. THX Onyx for iOS requires the slim Apple Lightning to USB Camera Adapter (sold separately.) All other Lightning adapters are incompatible, including the wide Apple Lightning to USB 3 Camera Adapter.




- 2 Launch the Onkyo HF Player app.
- 3 Tap the gear icon and choose **Settings.**






4 Scroll down and set **DSD Output Format** to **DoP**. If you receive a disclaimer message, choose "Agree and Continue."



5 Under Playback, turn off **Upsampling Mode**.
